6. All files on Reinhard Heydrich in Berlin Document Centre are in my possession on microfilm (ca 300pp.) I donated a set of copies to Heider Heydrich.
7. Note on interview of Heider Heydrich, geb.1934, at Grüneck bei München, Fasanenweg; 17.März 1971.
 - a) Heider Heydrich recalls as boy of eight the solid wall of working class Czechs passing endlessly by the Bähre on which rested his father's body at Prager Burg. Women in Trachten (mourning dress) and carrying flowers. Result of Heydrich's introduction of old age pensions, social security &c.
 - b) Has 16mm films of father's family life -- in the garden etc.
 - c) One month before his death Heydrich and Canaris held a joint family evening: Heydrich played the violin and Canaris the piano. Rumours of rivalry are untrue.
 - d) Has SS and navy daggers of a father, also uniforms, medals, etc.
 - e) Has private letters of Heydrich to his wife, covering the Navy and Bavarian police periods, but less of the later years.
