

Current hygiene regulations and information for visitors to the IfZ

- As of September 2nd 2021 the "3-G-rule" (access only for vaccinated, tested or recovered persons) also applies at the IfZ once local incidence reaches 35 or higher.
- Please enter the IfZ only when in good health and wearing a medical mask (or a mask with a higher standard). By entering the building, you confirm abiding by the previously mentioned 3-G-rule and being able to prove it. The usual digital or printed confirmations are accepted as proof. Unfortunately, self-test results won't be accepted.
- Proceed first to **reception** to fill out the **forms** available there.
- Then please wash your hands and make use of the **hygienic station** in the main hall.
- Please wear a mask within the premises of the institute at all times.
 You may remove it at the desks in the reading rooms.
- Please also always follow the general **distancing rules** as well as the **coughing and sneezing etiquette**.
- Enter the registration and advisement room only one at a time.
- The use of the reading rooms is currently only permitted with written pre-registration. To reserve your seat, please write to anmeldung lesesaal@ifz-muenchen.de in time (at least one business day in advance).
- Due to **reduced seating capacities**, seating is only available to those who require the materials of the IfZ archive and library for their work.
- Tours are not available for the time being.
